
Beach Festival Gear

Lean On Me

Rodders Beach Festival wouldn't be possible without the support of the local Hibiscus Coast community and beyond. It takes an army of kind-hearted individuals and businesses to run this popular three-day event at the Orewa Reserve (Auckland Anniversary Weekend: Friday 26th, Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th January 2024).

Every year they, together with the Hibiscus Rodders Club, raise tens of thousands of dollars in support of the Auckland Westpac Rescue Helicopter service – helping see multiple lives saved. Every participant, attendee or contributor, a hero in their own way.

One such local legend is Dean Morris, owner of Raw Possessions – a bespoke steel fabrication business in the heart of Silverdale.

"Dean and his team have been of incredible value over the years," says Sharon Morris (no relation to Dean) founder of the festival, "Their creations keep getting bigger and better and we are ever so grateful."

For the past three years, Raw Possessions have generously donated one-of-a-kind bar leaners which always sell well at Saturday's Live Auction. For the 2024 Rodders Beach Festival, the team wanted to go one better and build something extra special.

Three fabricators worked on the "automotive-themed" bar leaner, taking an estimated 100 hours to complete.

"This is the ultimate addition to any garage or cave," Dean says, "We sourced some really cool 'Detroit Steel' parts from yards to make it. Its creation was a very organic process and evolved as we went. The footrest, for example, was chain sourced from a neighbour's skip







A member of Hibiscus Rodders for two years, Dean's love of hot rods began five years ago.

He is the proud owner of a 66' Chevy Fleetside Truck. Living in Stanmore Bay, he often sees the Auckland Westpac Rescue Helicopter flying over. Also a keen boatie, Dean has never needed it and hopes he never will.

Dean has been blown away by visitors' comments about the leaner. He encourages everyone to get out their wallet out and give generously in support of the chopper.

The reserve price is set at \$4,500.




