

If they weren't we would, as a club, have to go it alone and employ legal counsel and accounting expertise to do it for us, the cost would be substantial. There still will be costs for us.

FOMOC

Speaking of FOMOC something else they have been working on for our benefit is biofuels, these aren't suitable for most of our club cars and in fact aren't suitable for most pre 2005 vehicles and a lot of pre 2010. It's not a done deal yet but there has been an acceptance now at official levels that provision should be made in the future for access to the standard fuels that we use.
